We have modified our Intake Process this year to include an online application. All pertinent information related to the application process is contained within our new website.

Educational Requirements

You <u>MUST</u> provide an Official Ontario High School Transcript (original or certified true copy) indicating successful completion of High School. If you were educated outside of the Province of Ontario then you will need to get your documents assessed by I.C.A.S. (additional information is contained on the website). If you do not already possess a *Comprehensive Report* from I.C.A.S. then you will not be able to apply for this Intake.

To be eligible to apply you must have successfully completed two (2) of the three (3) subjects listed below. It is highly recommended that you acquire all three (3) required courses BEFORE the application process.

English ENG4C, ENG4U, ENG4G, ENG4A

Physics SPH3U, SPH4C, SPH4U, SPH4G, SPH4A

Math MCT4C, MGA4U, MDM4U, MCV4U, MHF4U, MCB4U, MTT4G, MAT4A, MCR3U,

MAP4C (with minimum 70%), MCF3M (with minimum 65%)

If you have a G.E.D., please contact the JAC office for further application instructions.

Very Important

In order to be able to complete the online application you must have:

- Original or Certified True copy of your Ontario high school transcript.
- If currently in high school and graduating in June of 2018, your latest transcript and a Credit Counselling Summary Report from the Guidance department is required.
- If educated outside the province of Ontario, you must have a Comprehensive Report from ICAS. Please refer to the FAQ section on the website for specific details.
