

Update August 21, 2020

The Federal Government has extended the CERB benefits for an additional 4 weeks. The trustees are meeting next week to consider extending the Relief Grant the same number of weeks. Another update will be done once the decision of the trustees has been made.

The Federal Government has announced EI reforms and the trustees will look at it if it becomes official and will update as needed in the future.

The IBEW Password which is: IBEW2

Your Membership Card Number: That is the number on your IBEW Membership Card for example 1234567, A123456 or D123456. If you do not know your Membership Card Number or do not have one, you can use any unique number such as your home phone number or postal code **without any spaces** for example 4169492211 or L3P4R9.

The **First time** that you sign on, you will need to enter a little extra information so that VuBiz can set you up.
