

The grievance procedure has a very tight timeline for dealing with a violation of the Collective Agreement.

In Step 1, the onus is upon the member to verbally tell their employer that the agreement has been violated within five (5) days of when the violation occurred. For example if you received your pay on Thursday and noticed that it was short hours, you MUST report it to your employer no later than five (5) days from when you knew or ought to have known the violation occurred. Your employer MUST reply within one (1) working day to you. If it is still not resolved the grievance will proceed to Step 2 at which time the Local will write up the grievance and deliver it to the employer within two (2) working days. At this point the Local and your employer will attempt to resolve the grievance within two (2) working days. If it still has not been settled the grievance will proceed to Step 3 in which a Low-Rise Residential Grievance Board shall be convened within three (3) working days and a decision rendered within three (3) days from the Board meeting. The total time from start to finish should be no more than 16 working days.

I would once again like to thank the members of the low-rise sector who came out to ratify their agreement and remind the rest of the low-rise members who didn't make it out to the meeting that one of the most important things you can do to improve your working conditions is to be educated on your collective agreement. Building solidarity within your own ranks will pay off in the long run to better your collective lives. Breaking a single pencil is easy to do but trying to break a package of pencils cannot be done. Do not be a single pencil......get involved. Below you will find the new rate sheet for this year.
